Hello and Welcome to the 31st Annual Kitchen Kapers Tour!





Kitchen Kapers is proud to have Mark Taylor as the Tour Honorary Spokesperson. Mark joined NBC4 in December 2016 as co-anchor of the 5pm news. He is thrilled to call Columbus home and is developing a growing wardrobe of scarlet and gray!

Mark is an award winning journalist who has covered deadly tornadoes in Oklahoma, devastating floods in Colorado and destructive wildfires in Oregon. He is also a nationally published writer and Huffington Post contributor.

Most recently, Mark was the weekend anchor at the CBS affiliate in Denver, Colorado where he covered the aftermath and sentencing of the Aurora theater

shooter's trial. He was also on the front lines of Colorado's devastating flood in 2013 that caused millions of dollars in damage and left several dead.

Before Denver, Mark was the weekend anchor at the Fox affiliate in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma where he was one of the first reporters on the scene after the 2013 Moore Tornado which killed more than two dozen people and caused two billion dollars in damage. His investigative reporting in the aftermath revealed mistakes made by the OKC animal shelter and the accidental euthanization of a family dog, which led to new changes in procedure.

Mark has also been a reporter and anchor in Phoenix Arizona and Eugene, Oregon. He graduated from The Walter Cronkite School of Journalism at Arizona State University with a degree in Mass Communications and Journalism.

Mark was born in Phoenix, Arizona but both his parents are from Toronto, Canada. In his free time you can catch him at Starbucks, the gym, or hanging out with his pug Paige.



Hall Home

2000 W. DEVON ROAD

Welcome to 2000 West Devon Road, home of Clayton and Virginia Hall, their son James, and golden retriever Welly. The Halls spent nearly 2 years searching for the right home for their growing family in Upper Arlington from their Short North neighborhood. Almost immediately upon purchasing the home, which was built in 1917, they hired the Matrka Group to begin renovations. After multiple interviews, Matrka stood out as the front runner due to their transparency regarding the time frame, and their shared passion in transforming this home into the exceptional and uniquely beautiful space it is today.

Every single room on the first and second floors were touched and customized in some form or another. The first floor doesn't lack a single detail, including an office space for Clayton, a breakfast nook, a dry bar, a built in desk area, a spacious family room, a mudroom by the side door with a powder room for guests, a traditional dining space, and an adult living area. The Halls both knew they wanted the first floor to have a natural flow throughout, and to maximize the kitchen space. The existing white oak floors were all refinished and restained. When they originally purchased the home, the kitchen space had 3 separate ceiling heights which were all leveled out to one to modernize the home.

Virginia, being a designer, knew that natural light was a priority in the new design as well as keeping with their traditional aesthetic with rare and one of a kind pieces tied in throughout. This home is the perfect balance of modern living meets classic style. The stunning kitchen boasts an impressive 9 foot island made from honed Calcutta Gold Marble and a dry bar off to the left complete with wire detailing and a wine fridge. The slab was fabricated by Chester A. Smith. In addition to a custom hood with nickel strapping, the Kitchen Aid appliances are flawlessly hidden behind paneling to add to the clean and timeless look. The cabinets and trim were painted in White Dove. The lighting adds additional visual appeal with cone pendants, as well as a iron lantern above the breakfast nook. The backsplash is simple and stunning with handmade ceramic white subway tile in an unconventional 3 x 12 instead of the standard 3 x 6. The 48 inch Wolf Range makes for the ideal place to cook and would make any chef envious.





Even the windows were replaced to a galvanized, steel coating to showcase the outstanding landscaping and backyard. Every single piece of this kitchen was given careful thought and consideration. The entire project from start to finish

took roughly 7 months. Enjoy your visit to this beautiful space The Hall family has so graciously welcomed us into today to benefit the Bing Cancer Center and the fight against Cancer.



DeVoe Home

2200 CAMBRIDGE BOULEVARD

Welcome to 2200 Cambridge Boulevard, home of Anne and Keith DeVoe and their two children, Maddie and Andrew. The home was built in 1939 and purchased by the DeVoes in 2004. The owners were looking for a historic home that they could restore and make their family home. While the home had been neglected over the years and needed lots of work, they were immediately drawn to the home's location on a corner lot at the top of a hill. The home gets a lot of light and has great views. The homeowners also love that they see many friends and neighbors passing by on Cambridge.

In 2016, they kicked off renovations to their kitchen, mudroom and powder room. The original galley kitchen was dark and easily crowded when hosting gatherings. The DeVoes wanted a new space designed to accommodate lots of people (including multiple chefs at one time) and serve as an additional family hang out space. Anne's vision for the new kitchen was a white and bright space with timeless style and understated elegance. The simplicity of the color scheme, timeless materials and cabinet style are intended to seamlessly blend with the original 1930's character while also providing a stylish modern feel.

The spacious kitchen includes white painted cabinetry adorned with polished nickel hardware from Restoration Hardware, a large honed Carrera marble island and a feature wall for art. The

kitchen is designed with numerous windows, few upper cabinets and canned lights rather than pendants over the island—all with the goal of creating an airy and open space that is filled with natural light. Other features of the kitchen include a Thermador double oven range and refrigerator. The DeVoes love the new space and often can be found in the kitchen working, reading, drawing, or just spending time together.

The understated landscaping was inspired by country homes in England and France and adds the finishing touches to a very special property.

As you walk through be sure to enjoy the DeVoes extensive art collection ranging from gallery pieces, gems found during travels, family heirlooms and work by their children. Thank you for visiting this masterfully restored home.







Tucker Home


2577 EDINGTON ROAD

Welcome to 2577 Edington Rd, a house built in 1951 but transformed by their modern day owners Jack and Lyndsey Tucker. The home was originally a ranch that had a second floor addition put on by the previous owners. Despite its great bones, this mid-century ranch was in desperate need of a face lift and thanks to the partnership of contractor Clint Rex, a whole new life was brought to this classic Arlington abode. The seven month renovation took the house down to the studs. Some of the major changes included taking out walls to give the house an open concept floor plan and moving the existing kitchen from the now mudroom, into the middle of the house creating the ideal space to host and entertain.

The exterior stone was coated in the perfect shade of white while the windows and trim were changed to a warm black that contrasts beautifully against the stark nature of the white paint and the warm compliment of the brass exterior lighting. All new windows and French glass doors by Anderson were a needed addition to give the house an abundance of natural light. Being a family that enjoys having their friends and family over, they added a side porch off the front of the home that is both welcoming yet functional. It has outdoor couches and chairs along with a tv to provide yet another comfortable space to watch their favorite shows and games. Lyndsey, who has a natural eye for style, along with help of her designer, Laura Hawk, LCH Interiors, designed the interior of the home to be in Lyndsey's words "rustic glam."

Upon walking into this stunning home, your eyes are immediately drawn to the classic theme of white, black and gold

(Lyndsey's favorite colors). The front foyer immediately opens up into the large modern kitchen with a breakfast nook beyond. To your left are the living room and formal dining room. The main walls in the house are painted in Benjamin Moore white dove while the shiplap that wraps around the re-centered fireplace was done in that same color but in a satin sheen and finished off with a wood beam for warmth. The 8 1/4" wood floors in a white washed natural water stain stretch the length of the home and continue the light, refreshing feel that the Tuckers were used to in their previous home in Southern California. The Imperial Danby marble surfaces and brass visual comfort and Restoration Hardware lighting are elegant and timeless. The dining room is wallpapered in an eye catching black and white leopard that has become the conversation piece of the home. Next door to the dining room the butler's pantry holds its own with the white glass herringbone tile, complimented by



custom mixed gold grout. Just past the butler pantry is the new powder bath and mudroom, both of which are not to be ignored. The mudroom immediately grabs your attention with the black and white herringbone laid floors and black painted lockers with shoe storage underneath and brass hardware/lighting to warm things up! The slate colored Native Trails concrete sink and statuary marble counters make this mudroom/laundry room a space anyone would love to spend time in. The powder room which also shares this space is wallpapered in a cole and son animal print and soapstone counter. The entire space can be easily closed off by the reclaimed wood sliding door, which any parent of three kids needs for those days when laundry is piled high and shoes and coats aren't put in their place. This incredible region of the home is every bit functional as it is beautiful.

Walking back into the kitchen down the back hallway you cannot ignore the highlight of the new kitchen, which is its 10' island. This gorgeous sprawling centerpiece is wrapped in custom hickory to match the hood, both stained in a white wash and then torched to Lyndsey's specifications to create a unique and distressed look. The top is a thick slab of honed Imperial Danby that ties in all the natural elements of the home while giving

the kitchen a truly unparalleled elegance. The perimeter cabinetry match the walls in the Benjamin Moore white dove finish complimented by brass hardware. The homeowner worked closely with Miller Cabinet Company to bring her vision to life. The range backsplash is done in a brick laid marble with a brass pot-filler to complete the look. The Thermador fridge and freezer which frame in the large wine fridge are all neighbors to the spacious walk in pantry. The pantry is fitted with custom reclaimed wood counters that host a beverage center and store all the families smaller appliances. There is even a window in this space to allow for natural light. The pantry can be closed off by the custom iron and glass sliding door that Lyndsey designed. Whether its sitting in the custom leather breakfast bench eating a meal or stretched out watching a show on the navy velvet tufted sofa in the family room, this sightly residence is both warm and tasteful, the perfect domicile for this trend setting family of 5.



Cold caps treatment



Anne's Story

I was diagnosed with stage 1A breast cancer on November 25, 2016. When my husband and I sat down to tell our two school-age kids about my breast cancer, my 7-year-old son had three immediate questions for me: "Are you going to die?" (Nope, not from this.) It was about dignity, and anonymity, and privacy. Cold caps allowed others to view me as a healthy person. Most importantly, in the eyes of my kids, I just looked like me.

Since completing my chemo and successfully using cold caps, I've been talking to anyone who will listen to my story.
