



Britton Home

2851 EXMOOR ROAD

Eclectic is an understatement when it comes to all things Jeni Britton. With the help of Sullivan Builders, Jeni's Canterbury-area home is as varied and beautiful as her world-famous ice cream.

Upon entering, the house is awash in natural light and dynamic backgrounds that set the stage for everything from lively family dinners to full camera-crew videos. The kitchen immediately pops with dancing colors of the terrazzo countertops. Reminiscent of sprinkles in ice cream, the countertops are from a company in California created from Venice Alabaster Large Mixed Chip. The countertops were used as the foundation to set the tone for the look of the rest of the kitchen. The counter seems to melt over onto the mosaic floor, which is

American Olean mosaic in Light Smoke and was selected for its period-specific look. Adding to the charm and texture of the original house, the floor keeps the eye flowing to the rest of the kitchen.

The skylight tunnels over the island have electronic louvers built in and are controlled by a switch under the island sink, so Jeni can add natural light when filming in the space. As a creative and a cook, Jeni had specific needs that were laid out ahead of time as the kitchen and surrounding areas were updated

from their compartmentalized layout common for the time. An open flow kitchen was not the norm when the house was built, it was and would have been more of a closed off workspace for one of the family members, or perhaps a staff member to cook in. The appliances in this updated but periodappropriate kitchen are from GE Café. Combining the power of a commercial kitchen with the runway styling of a home, the color and finish of the appliances could be customized to match Jeni's personality and home.

One of the most important things when designing the space was keeping the feeling that it was 'always the way the house was laid out.' This meant that nothing looked out of place in the 1953 home. Other than the kitchen, only a few key areas of the home were updated, with the rest remaining true

to the original design. The front door was replaced with a solid walnut door and the foyer interior and exterior trim were renovated to create a board and batten detail. The powder bath and hallway were remodeled with new tile, a new vanity and plumbing fixtures. The Phylrich faucet and Kohler Sink in French Gold complement perfectly the tap in the powder room, which was something that fit the era of the house and Jeni's personality perfectly, but choosing a black finish updated it with a modern look.

A place where she and her family can freely let their creativity flow, this home is a perfect representation of the spirit and personality that shines so bright in our Columbus community.







What is cold cap therapy?



Cold cap therapy aims to prevent or minimize chemotherapyinduced hair loss. It involves the use of a special set of caps, cooled to very cold temperatures and worn on the head before, during and after each chemotherapy treatment. These cold temperatures constrict the blood vessels in the scalp. This may prevent some chemotherapy drugs from reaching the hair follicles, thus preventing or reducing hair loss.

75% of the cold cap program at OhioHealth has been funded through the donations from Kitchen Kapers. Specifically, \$50,000 was allocated to the program from the 2021 Tour.

Walking through the main doors of the home Meghan and Steve share with their three kids, you're greeted with a space that feels both open-concept and distinctly individual. The library is dark and moody with a glass table that brings a 50's-style cocktail lounge look, while the art and built-in shelves help it flow seamlessly into the hallway. Opening

into a living space with multiple seating areas, this part of the home is the perfect setting for the many family gatherings, get togethers and happy hours hosted here.
